#### **PARKING & SHUTTLES**

RTS Routes #13 & #41 drop near the park. No parking at 1111 Elmwood Ave, Goodman St., or side streets, where posted.

Parking Lot 1 – Main Festival Lot (no shuttle from this lot)

- Elmwood Ave between South Clinton & South Ave (west of Meadowbrook Rd)
- Opens daily at 10 AM
- Rates: \$7 (Mon–Fri before 2:30 PM), \$10 after 2:30 PM & weekends
- Accessible Parking: 1440 South Ave (valid tag required; limited spaces)

Parking Lot 2 – Golisano Institute, 150 Sawgrass Dr. (weekends only)

- Free parking + \$5/person shuttle (13+); 12 & under ride free

#### **ENTRY & SAFETY POLICIES**

For everyone's safety and enjoyment, the Rochester Lilac Festival prohibits pets, smoking or vaping, weapons, illegal drugs, and outside food or drinks (except one sealed water bottle or an empty one). Bags are subject to search, and guests will pass through security screening. Bikes, scooters, skateboards, and similar items are not allowed. Small chairs, blankets, strollers for children under 8, and ADA mobility devices are welcome. Guests 17 and under must be accompanied by a parent or guardian who is 21 or older at all times. ## **FOOD & BEVERAGE**

80+ vendors offering local fare, festival treats & drinks available every day, with additional offerings during Art in the Park & the Lilac Locals Farmers Market.

#### **ACCESSIBILITIES AND AMENITIES**

The **Sensory Tent**, presented by the Office for People with Developmental Disabilities and supported by Autism Up, is near the Elmwood Avenue Entrance/Exit at the Pergola area and is open daily. It offers a quiet space with soft lighting, headphones, and seating.

First Aid: Visit the 1440 South Ave. main entrance and ask for the Command Center.

**Restrooms:** Portable and accessible units, including ADA-compliant units (notated on the official Festival map), are available throughout the grounds.
