Monroe County is proud to present the public review draft of *Plan Forward – A Comprehensive Plan* for Monroe County, the first County Comprehensive Plan in 40 years. Since August of 2021, Monroe County has been meeting with community members to better understand their priorities for the future of Monroe County.

We've held 50+ pop-up meetings, two public meetings, six steering committee meeting, four municipal-focused group meetings, five topic-focused stakeholder meetings, and received 250+ comment cards, along with countless in-person conversation and phone calls.
