STOP-DWI Victim Impact Panel Check-in

Use our registration system for client check-in and identity confirmation, including payment collection and providing instructions.

Schedule: 5:30 to 7 PM.

STOP-DWI Victim Impact Panel Facilitating Videos & Presentations on Projector

Run scheduled videos and presentations for panelists, ensuring proper audio and video, from 6:30 to 8:15 PM.

STOP-DWI Victim Impact Panel Instructions

Instruct clients before entering the auditorium and ensure they read the rules that you will hand out. Facilitate questions with staff. Schedule: 5:30 to 7 PM.

STOP-DWI Victim Impact Panel Direct Lines

Remind attendees to prepare their ID and payments, directing them to the correct line based on their status. The schedule is from 5:30 to 7 PM.

STOP-DWI Victim Impact Panel Cleanup

Assist with cleaning up the panel setup after completion with STOP-DWI staff from 7:30 to 8:45 PM.
