DEPUTIES MAKE TWO ARRESTS IN COUNTY-WIDE BURGLARY SPREE

Investigation is Ongoing

Monroe County, NY (May 16, 2018) — On 5/11/18, The Monroe County Sheriff's Office arrested Dean Klejment, 51, Rochester and Joseph Mullen, 35, Irondequoit after a lengthy investigation into burglaries and vehicle larcenies in the city of Rochester and Monroe County's Eastside. Klejment admitted to investigators he was responsible for numerous residential burglaries and vehicle larcenies in Irondequoit, Perinton, Pittsford, and Rochester. Klejment was bringing property he stole to Mullen's Irondequoit residence. The Sheriff's Office, with the assistance of NYS Parole and Irondequoit Police, executed a search warrant at Mullen's residence. Mullen was taken into custody and approximately \$30,000 worth of stolen power tools and equipment were recovered. Klejment was arraigned in Perinton town court on Burglary 2nd and Petit Larceny charges. Klejment is a predicate felon and was remanded to the Monroe County Jail without bail. Mullen was remanded to the Monroe County Jail on a parole violation. Later a warrant was lodged out of the town of Irondequoit for Criminal Possession of Stolen Property 5th.
