



## MONROE COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPUTIES CHARGE HOTEL MANAGER WITH GRAND LARCENY AND FALSIFYING BUSINESS RECORDS

Suspect Stole Tens of Thousands over the Course of Two Years

**Penfield, NY (July 31, 2019)** – On July 18, 2019, Monroe County Sheriff's Deputy Bret Zawadzki responded to the Hampton Inn, located at 950 Panorama Trail, Penfield, for a larceny report. The hotel was alerted by its bank to several transactions for unusually high dollar amounts being deposited into another account. The hotel's upper management received information that hotel manager Bryan McGillvray, 30, Rochester, was responsible for the illegal transactions, and through an audit discovered McGillvray had been altering business records and stealing money from the company since early 2017. In total, McGillvray stole \$42,000 over the past two (2) years while employed at the Penfield Hampton Inn and the Hampton Inn, located at 4873 Lake Rd. S., Sweden.

## **CHARGES:**

Grand Larceny, 3<sup>rd</sup> degree (*D-Felony*) Falsifying Business Records, 1<sup>st</sup> degree (*E-Felony*)

Deputy Zawadzki conducted a thorough investigation into the incident, and as a result of the investigation, McGillvray was arrested on July 29, 2019 at the MCSO Zone-A Substation and charged with Falsifying Business Records in the 1<sup>st</sup> degree (E-Felony) and Grand Larceny in the 3<sup>rd</sup> degree (D-Felony). McGillvray was arraigned in Sweden Town Court and released on his own recognizance. He is scheduled to appear back in court on August 7<sup>th</sup>.

Special thanks to Deputy Zawadzki for taking the lead on this case, doing a thorough and detailed investigation, and helping to end McGillvray's two-year crime spree.
