Henrietta, NY- (June 2, 2020) - The Monroe County Sheriff's Office is incredibly appreciative of its deputies, New York State troopers, and officers from throughout the county who worked all weekend to address riot control, responding to looting and hundreds of calls for service in the city of Rochester and Monroe County.

MCSO is especially proud of the deputies who responded to the AT&T store, located at 620 Jefferson Road in the Town of Henrietta, on Sunday, May 31, 2020 at 12:41 a.m. for the glass break alarm that was activated. Upon arrival, deputies observed the front glass door broken and four males inside the location. When confronted by deputies, the four male suspects ran from the scene. After a brief foot chase, deputies took one suspect into custody across the street from the location. A successful K-9 track then led deputies to two other suspects at a business on Jay Scutti Blvd. Deputies were unable to locate the 4th male. The investigation into the identification of the 4th suspect continues. The suspects were found in possession of stolen property from AT&T.

MCSO deputies charged Tevin Giles (22, Rochester), Anthony Sargeant Jr. (25, Rochester) and William Maddox (33, Rochester) with: Burglary 3rd (Class-D Felony), Criminal Mischief 2nd (Class-D Felony) and Grand Larceny 3rd (Class-D Felony). All three men were arraigned in Henrietta Town Court. Giles and Sargeant were released on their own recognizance. Maddox was remanded to the Monroe County Jail and released following a hearing on June 2, 2020.
