Parma, NY- (June 10, 2020) - On Wednesday, June 10, 2020, at 1:53 a.m., the Monroe County Sheriff's Office responded to the Speedway Gas Station, located at 5028 West Ridge Road in the Town of Parma, for the glass break alarm that was activated. While deputies were responding, an ambulance that was parked across the street viewed the crime in progress and notified dispatch. The ambulance was able to provide a vehicle description and a deputy spotted a vehicle matching that description on Manitou Road. The deputy stopped the vehicle and detained all three occupants. Stolen property from the Speedway Gas Station was located inside of the vehicle.

At the scene, deputies discovered the front door of the Speedway was smashed in and items had been stolen from inside of the closed store. The three suspects were transported to the C Zone Substation and were interviewed by investigators.

MCSO deputies charged Tricia Delucia (42, Rochester), Kirk Thomas (35, Rochester) and Eric Smith (34, Rochester) with: Burglary 3rd (Class-D Felony), Criminal Mischief 4th (Class-A Misdemeanor) and Grand Larceny 4th (Class-E Felony). All three suspects were released with an appearance ticket per a county court judge.
