UNARRAIGNED INCARCERATED INDIVIDUAL DISPLAYING FLU-LIKE SYMPTOMS CONSISTENT WITH COVID-19 HOUSED AT MCSO BRIGHTON FACILITY DESIGNATED AS COVID-19 CONFINEMENT AREA

Individual Faces Violent Felony Charges Lodged by the Rochester Police Department

Brighton, NY (**April 3, 2020**) – On today's date, April 3, 2020 the Rochester Police Department transported an un-arraigned individual facing violent felony charges, as lodged by RPD, to the Monroe County Jail, located at 130 S. Plymouth Ave., Rochester. Before entering the secure facility, the individual was screened by jail medical staff. Upon screening, it was determined the individual was displaying flu-like symptoms consistent with COVID-19.

Out of an abundance of caution, RPD transported the individual to MCSO's Brighton facility, deemed the COVID-19 Confinement Area, located at 750 E. Henrietta Rd. The individual was booked, processed and placed in a housing area designated for medical isolation. The individual will remain in this area for a minimum 14 days.

While in medical isolation, the individual will be seen and cared for by MCSO's medical and mental health staff on a regular basis to include daily medical checkups.
