

Visitation FAQ

Q: How can I schedule a visit at the Monroe County Jail?

A: Visits are scheduled 7 days in advance (Monday for the following Monday, Tuesday for the following Tuesday, etc..).

To schedule a visit, the public can call 753-4000 or schedule in person at the appointment window located in the Visits Lobby, Monday-Friday from the hours of 08:45-12:00.

Visits can be scheduled online at <https://www2.monroecounty.gov/sheriff-jail-visitation-form> and this form is accessible at any time.

You may also call 753-4000 to schedule your visit.

Q: How do I schedule a visit at the Andrew P. Meloni: Star Academy at MCF?

A: Visits are scheduled 7 days in advance. Visits may be scheduled in person at the appointment window located in the front lobby of the building. Appointment scheduling hours are Tuesday from 9:30am-2:30pm.

Q: How do I arrange a “first time” visit?

A: Each inmate is entitled to receive one, thirty-minute unscheduled visit within 72 hours of his/her admission into the facility. Arrangements for this visit are made at the registration desk in the Jail Visits lobby. All first time visits will be accommodated on a first come, first serve basis during regular visitation hours. First time visits cannot take place until the inmate is transported back from court and processed into the facility. This generally takes up to 2 hours from the time of arraignment.
