Job Summary:

This is a professional golfing position, located at the Monroe County Department of Parks, responsible for overseeing and participating in golf related activities at one of the following parks: Durand Eastman, Genesee Valley and Churchville Parks. Duties include providing golf lessons, golf repair, and advice to the public, handling public relations, overseeing the daily activities of a golf pro shop, restaurant and other related activities, and ensuring the public and staff conform to the rules and regulations of the assigned golf course. The employee reports directly to, and works under the general supervision of the Golf Services Manager or other higher level staff member. General supervision is exercised over seasonal laborers. Does related work as required.

Residency Requirement:

Must be a Monroe County resident.

<u>Minimum Qualifications</u>: Must be a Class 'A' or Class 'AA" Professional Golf Association (PGA) of America qualified professional.

Special Requirements: Must obtain a valid Level I – Food Handler in Charge certificate approved by the Monroe County Department of Public Health during the probationary period.

If you are appointed you will be required to possess a valid operator's license in New York State or otherwise demonstrate your ability to meet the transportation needs of the job.

Additional Information:

- 1. Pass a pre-employment drug test.
- 2. Physical condition commensurate with outside work.
- 3. Must be at least 18 years of age or older.
